



Dear Valuable Supplier,

We as Wittur are a global supplier of elevator components. As you are supplying articles that Wittur currently uses to produce components sold inside the European Union, it is mandatory to have evidences of compliance with the European regulations.

Furthermore, as a supplier in the sense of the REACH Regulation, we also have a legal obligation pursuant to Article 33(1) to provide certain information about the material composition of our products to our customers. In particular to this starting from 05/01/2021 it is mandatory to notify ECHA of the articles produced/assembled/imported and/or distributed if they contain substances classified SVHC (candidate substances of very high concern according to Article 59 of REACH) in concentration higher than 0,1% weight/weight.

All substances identified as SVHC are listed on the so-called "candidate list" (see the website of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA): www.echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table), which is updated if necessary with newly identified SVHC.

As you are producing, importing or selling products to Wittur, we need your compliance confirmation to REACH Regulation 1907/2006 via letter shared in Annex A.
